

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Friday February 15th.1924 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The Supervisor announced that six sealed proposals for the town highway bond issue, series of 1924, in the amount of \$ 80,000.00, advertised to be submitted and opened at 2 o'clock P. M. this day, had been received. It was thereupon regularly moved, seconded and carried that the Board proceed to open said proposals.

The six sealed proposals were thereupon opened in the presence of the entire board, and representatives of several of the bidders, and the following bids were found and announced:-

Curtis & Sanger, New York City, \$80,888.00

E. H. Rollins & Sons, New York City, \$80,264.00

Geo. B. Gibbons & Company, \$100.037 per \$100. par value

Suffolk County National Bank, Riverhead, N.Y., 100-1/8 per \$100. par value.

Union National Corporation, New York City, \$100.44 per

\$100. par value.

Roosevelt & Son, New York City, 100.071 per \$100. par value.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the following resolution was duly adopted:-

RESOLVED that the proposals and bids received ~~xxxxxxx~~ and heretofore opened and read, be filed with the Town Clerk, and be it further

RESOLVED that the bid of Curtis & Sanger of 49 Wall Street, New York City, of \$80,888.00 be, and the same is hereby declared to be the highest bid, and be it further

RESOLVED that the said bid of \$80,888.00 of said Curtis & Sanger be accepted, and that the entire issue of Town Highway Bonds, series of 1924, in the amount of \$80,000.00 be awarded to them, and be it further

RESOLVED that the Supervisor proceed with the preparation and execution of said bonds in accordance with law, and with the performance of all acts and conditions required herein, and the delivery of said bonds to said purchaser upon receipt of the full amount due at the time of such delivery pursuant to the said bid.


On motion made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be directed to install in accordance with their contract, seven additional street lamps upon Cemetery Avenue, Baynor Avenue, West Street and Old Country Road in accordance with and at the places designated in the sketch submitted.

On motion made seconded and carried the Receiver of Taxes was allowed an extension of two weeks for his clerk.
