

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Saturday May 10th, 1924 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion made by Justice Corwin and seconded by Justice Vail and duly carried the Supervisor was directed to request the State Comptroller to render his opinion upon the proceedings as to the Town Park, and the status thereof, particularly with the regard to the expenditure of the funds raised by tax levy of 1923 inserted in the tax warrant as "Town Park, \$ 5000.00", for the construction and improvement of the highway laid out from Sound Avenue to the proposed park as contemplated in said proceeding.

On motion made by Justice Vail, seconded by Justice Corwin and duly carried it was resolved that the northerly bridge on Peconic Avenue be widened to conform with the highway line.

The Superintendent of Highways stated that the foregoing improvement ^{could be completed} for the sum of \$ 500.00 together with the unexpended balance of the funds for the improvement of Peconic Avenue on the west side in the construction of the retaining wall.

On motion made by Justice Vail, seconded by Justice Corwin and duly carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 500.00 in anticipation of taxes and place to the credit of the Highway Bridge Fund for the purpose of the widening of the northerly bridge on Peconic Ave., on the east side.

On motion made by Justice Vail, seconded by the Town Clerk and duly carried the Supervisor was authorized to obtain liability insurance against personal and property damage to the amounts of \$20,000. and \$ 40,000. upon the two Ford dump body trucks now being leased under the contract with H.E.Campbell dated April 5th, 1924.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the meeting
of the board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office
on May 16th, 1924 at 7-30 P.M.
