Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Mr. Anthony Schaefer addressed the Board with reference to additional street lights on Osborne Avenue.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the matter was laid on the table, and the Clerk was instructed to examine the records for former resolutions on the subject and report.

Mrs. Valentine Maks and several other ladies residents of Osborne Avenue addressed the board with reference to procuring an extension of the Lighting District for street lighting purposes north on Osborne Avenue.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the purchase of Electric fans and contract for wiring made by the Town Clerk on June 25th, 1924, with Overton Electric Co. was ratified and confirmed.

The Town Clerk presented bill of W.N. Burnite No. 3613 for \$8.75 and the bill of William L. Miller No. 3614 for \$ 75.00 which he stated had been referred to the Town Board by the Board of Auditors for approval.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the said bill of W.N. Burnite was referred back to the Board of Audit for payment in accordance with the Town Law.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the said bill of William L. Miller was referred to the Board of Assessors.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon demand promissory note from the Suffolk County Trust Co, the sum of \$ 6580.00, to pay the purchase price of the voting machines purchased in accordance with the resolution of this board

dated June 11th, 1924, and be it further
RESOLVED that upon the receipt of said sum upon said note
the Supervisor pay said purchase price of said voting
machines to the Automatic Registering Machine Company, in
accordance with its contract with the town and with said
resolution.

The Town Clerk read the opinion of Almon G. Rasquin,
attorney with relation to the authority to render financial
assistance to George Salter of the Riverhead Fire Dep't or
to pay any claim that may be presented. The board having
been thereby advised that no such payments could be made
it was on motion duly made seconded and carried RESOLVED
that this board present the same to the next session of
the Legislature to obtain remedial legislation in the
premises.

The committee to investigate the alteration of Cemetery
Street reported that the conditions necessitated an alter-
ation of the lines between Marcy and Raynor Avenues and that
the owners of the property through which such alteration
would pass have agreed to release the same for a total sum
of \$500.00.

On motion made seconded and carried the committee was
continued and the Superintendent of Highways was requested
to make the proper application for such alteration and
present the same to the town board.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was RESOLVED
that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be, and they hereby are
authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note from
the Suffolk County Trust Co. the sum of \$ 2200.00 to pay
audited bills of July 29th, 1924.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the request of
the Long Island Railroad Co. for license to construct and
maintain a six inch water pipe at Union Street was laid on
the table.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved
that the members of this board meet at the Town Clerk's
office on August 1st, 1924 at 9-00 A.M. to visit and inspect
the beach road at Wading River and to confer with the
Westchester Construction Co, regarding reimbursement for
damage done to said road.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the board
adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on August 11th,
1924 at 7-30 P.M.
