Minutes of meeting held Oct. 27th read and on motion adopted.


Town Clerk read a petition signed by twenty one residents and merchants along Main Street requesting that immediate steps be taken to concrete Main Street from Peconic Avenue to the Congregational Church from curb to curb.

Same was referred to the Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the Supervisor and Superintendent of Highways were appointed a committee to interview all the owners of property on both sides of Main Street between Peconic Avenue and Cat Alley to ascertain if such owners would pay for the curbing in conjunction with the paving of Main Street between those points.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 2800.00 to pay audited bills of October 28th, 1924.
