

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office, Wednesday, February 28th, 1923 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Town Clerk presented a petition signed by ten taxpayers in School District No.5 who are paying a fire tax and Mr. Balsler, Mr.Max and Mr.Schaefer three signers of said petition appeared before the board and stated that they paid a fire tax this year but were getting no fire protection.

Supervisor Dennis G.Homan appointed Justices Robert Burnside and Chauncey H.Young to investigate this matter and report at the next meeting.

Mr.Clifford Hudson appeared before the board and stated that he was the owner of some meadow land at the sound and that he would donate to the Town for a public park and asked the board if it would be possible for the town to build a road to this land and, if this could be done that the village of Sound Ave. would maintain it.

The above was referred to the Committee on Highways to the water for their investigation.

Town Clerk presented a petition signed by a majority of taxpayers on East Main Street requesting to be included in Electric Light District # 1. Same was referred to the Electric Light Committee.

On motion made seconded and carried the Riverhead Yacht Club were given authority to erect a derrick on the slip of the Town Dock. Same to be erected so that it will not interfere with the traffic up and down the dock.

Town Clerk read an opinion in regards to the different lighting districts and same was placed on file.

On motion made seconded and carried the salary of the Clerk to the Assessors was raised from \$ 1100.00 per annum to \$ 1300.00

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G.Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 500.00 to pay audited bills as of February 27th, 1923.

It was decided to hold the next townboard meeting on Wednesday, March 14th, at 2-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
