

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office Thursday, June 14th, 1923 at 7-30 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion made seconded and carried that Health Officer Alan G. Terrell be permitted to attend the Health Officers conference to be held at Saratoga Springs, N.Y. the latter part of June 1923.

The map received from the L.I.R.R. was presented and communication was read and ordered placed on file.

Town Clerk was instructed to write to the L.I.R.R. Co. to inform them that the Town Board considers the abutment at Jamesport an obstruction in the highway.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 800.00. Same to be placed to the account of the Water District to pay the interest on bonds.

The lighting district was discussed and the progress that was being made was approved.

The bank deposits of the Supervisor were approved by the Board.

Mr. Winfield Robinson appeared before the Board and made application to act as Motorcycle Officer in the Town of Riverhead.

On motion made seconded and carried that Winfield Robinson be engaged for one month on trial at \$ 7.00 per day and furnish his own machine and pay all expenses on same.

Town Clerk was instructed to write to the Insurance Company and find out if the Traffic Officers and Motorcycle Officers are covered in the policy issued to the Town.

On motion made seconded and carried that Justice William L. Miller engage a Traffic Officer to handle traffic at the beach at Wading River, on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. Pay for said officer not to exceed \$ 6.00 per day.

Town Clerk was instructed to get six copies of the Motor Vehicle Law from the Secretary of State.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
