Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Town Clerk Sollar read the opinion received from Mr. N. O. Petty, Attorney relative to the tax refund claimed by the Village of Sound Avenue and same was placed on file.

Justice Young and Mr. William L. McDermott were appointed a committee to arrange for a contract with the owners of property for the proposed road into the Town Park.

The Highway Superintendents estimate was thoroughly discussed but no action taken at this meeting.

On motion made seconded and carried it was ordered to have two lights placed on Roanoke Avenue above Franklin St. and Town Clerk was instructed to notify the Long Island Lighting Company of same.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 1400.00 to pay audited bills as of October 30th. 1923.

Town Clerk was instructed to obtain an opinion from an attorney relative to persons entitled to vote upon Town Appropriations.

It was decided to have the next meeting on Monday Nov. 5th. 1923 at 7-30 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
