

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, N.Y. held in the Town Clerk's office, Friday February 3rd. at 3-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Tax Receiver, Clinton T. Voorhees asked the Town Board for an extension of one week for his clerk at the rate of \$30.00 per week.

On Motion made seconded and carried Tax Receiver Clinton T. Voorhees was empowered to retain his clerk at the rate of \$30.00 per week, for one additional week.

Town Clerk read a communication received from Miss Grace A. Reeder, Director, Child Welfare Board in the case of Russell Hertzell.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00) to pay audited bills. The amount of audited bills being One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Five dollars and Forty Two cents (\$1765.42)

On motion made seconded and carried that the bill of John Stonebanks of Riverhead, N.Y. for lowering water pipe for Mr. Morris Peltz of Riverhead, N.Y. for the sum of \$ 26.44 for labor be paid by the Town of Riverhead.

Town Clerk presented a bill of John Bagshaw of Riverhead, N.Y. in the sum of \$ 310.00 for Bonds issued by the Fidelity and Casualty Co. of New York to Supervisor Dennis G. Homan, Town Clerk Frank Sollar and Sup't of Highways George H. Taft and same was laid aside until next meeting.

Town Clerk presented a petition received from S.W. Woollworth of Aquebogue, N.Y. representing Law and Order signed by a large majority of residents in that section which received attention and was *filed* by the Town Clerk.

brought up again and Supervisor Dennis G.Homan stated he would guarantee a competent clerk and guarantee his work for \$800.00 a year. It was debated and Justice George E.Penny made a compromise motion that Mr. Byron Rogers the present clerk be paid \$1000.00 it was seconded by Supervisor Dennis G.Homan and voted upon, vote standing Messers Penny, Sollar and Homan for, and Messers Flanagan, Burnside and Miller against. It was further debated and Mr. Flanagan moved that the clerk be paid \$ 1200.00 seconded by Justice Robert Burnside which went to vote as follows: Messers Burnside,, Flanagan and Miller for \$1200.00 with Messers Penny, Homan and Sollar against. No agreement could be reached.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
