

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, N.Y. held in the Town Clerks office, Friday February 24th. 1922 at 3-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Town Clerk Frank Sollar was instructed to strike out from the minutes of a meeting held Friday, February 3rd, 1922 the following:

It was further debated and Mr. Wm. F. Flanagan moved that the clerk be paid \$1200.00 seconded by Justice Robert Burnside which went to a vote as follows: Messers Burnside Flanagan and Miller for \$1200.00 with Messers Penny, Homan and Sollar against.

It was moved that the Clerk to the Board of Assessors be paid \$1100.00 per annum.

On motion made by Justice George E. Penny seconded by Justice Wm. F. Flanagan and carried the Clerk's salary was fixed at \$1100.00 per annum starting March 1st. 1922.

Justice Robert Burnside moved that the bill of John Bagshaw in the sum of \$ 262.50 for bonds issued by the Fidelity and Casualty Co. of New York to Supervisor Dennis G. Homan, Town Clerk Frank Sollar and Superintendent of Highways George H. Taft be paid.

It was decided that the next Town Board meetings would be held on the following dates: Friday, March 10th. and Friday, March 31st. at 3-00 P.M.

Town Clerk read a communication received from State Comptroller.

It was moved that Mr. ^{David E.} Gaddis be appointed Local Historian for the Town of Riverhead and Town Clerk was instructed to write to State Historian, James Sullivan and confirm this appointment.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
