

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office Friday, March 31st 1922 at 3-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion made seconded and carried the following resolution was adopted:

Final Resolution by Town Board.

Petition No. T-54 Highway No.

1. Whereas, under section 138-A of the Highway Law the Town Board of any town, may by resolution petition the State Commission of Highways to modify the plans for the improvement (State) highway to provide for a width greater than (Federal Aid) that originally Contemplated by the said Commission, or for a different style of construction, the excess cost occasioned by such modification to be borne by the Town; and
2. Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead County of Suffolk N.Y. did on the 25th. day of March 1921, adopt such resolution in regard to the improvement by State aid of the Port Jefferson-Riverhead, Part 2-B. Highway, No. ; and
3. Whereas, the Town Board has adopted resolutions providing for the raising of funds for the estimated additional cost either by authorizing the issuance and sale of Town bonds, or the levying of taxes.
4. Whereas, the State Commission of Highways has prepared plans, specifications and estimate of cost for the improvement of said highway to be known as the Port Jefferson-Riverhead, Part 2-B. Highway No. and has transmitted the same to this Board accompanied by a communication stating that the excess cost to be borne by the Town is \$ 23,900.00.
5. Resolved, That said plans, specifications and estimate be and the same are hereby approved.
6. It Is Further Resolved, That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Twenty two thousand nine hundred dollars, being the amount required of the town for such excess cost, including five percent for engineering charges, which amount is

hereby ordered deposited with the State Comptroller who is authorized and directed to pay the same at any time upon the joint requisition or draft of the State Commission of Highways and the State Comptroller of the State of New York in accordance with the Highway Law.

It Being Understood, That the State Comptroller is to refund to the proper town authorities any unexpended balance of said appropriation upon the completion of the work and after written notice to the State Comptroller from the State Commission of Highways to the effect that no further drafts will be made upon the said appropriation.

Town Clerk read a communication received from Mr. John R. Hogan relative to a wall on Peconic Ave, which is about ready to fall in and same was referred to Sup't of Highways George H. Taft to investigate and report at the next meeting.

Justice Robert Burnside and Justice George E. Penny were appointed a committee to investigate the road on Peconic Ave. and try and arrange a way to keep this road open while the concrete road was being laid.

Town Clerk presented a petition received from Mr. Authur J. Howell and same was placed on file.

Supervisor Dennis G. Homan reported that the building which had been used to house the town machinery was recently destroyed by fire and that the town has no place to house this machinery and same was referred to Sup't of Highways George H. Taft to try and locate some suitable place where the above could be kept and report at the next meeting.

Town Clerk presented a petition requesting one or more lights to be placed on Union Ave, in this village North of railroad track and same was referred to Supervisor Dennis G. Homan to investigate and report at the next meeting.

It was recommended that Sup't of Highways George H. Taft advertise for bids for road oil and that bids should be submitted by April 28th.

It was decided that the next Town Board meetings would be held on the following dates: April 14th. and April 28th.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
