

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office Friday, April 28 1922 at 3-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Bids for supplying road oil were submitted at the following prices F.O.B. Riverhead Town:

Standard Oil Co. .052
Union Petroleum Co. .0644

On motion made seconded and carried it was ordered that this Board and the Town Superintendent of Highways enter into contract with the Standard Oil Co.of New York for supplying approximately 100,000 gals or more if required of about 45 % asphalt road oil @ .052 per gal.F.O.B. at different railroad stations in Riverhead Town.

Town Clerk read a communication received from Mike Macksel and same was laid on the table.

On motion made seconded and carried Daniel R.Young was authorized to proceed with the building of the Peconic Ave. road and also to purchase sufficient number of eyebeams to be placed on the bridge on Peconic Ave.to make this bridge safe for the heavy traffic.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, \$ 700.00 to pay audited bills of April 25th.1922.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of One Thousand Sixty Six Dollars and ninety three cents \$ 1066.93 to pay highway bills of the year 1921. The Legislature having passed a bill permitting the payment of these bills.

Supervisor Dennis G.Homan appointed Justice William F. Flanagan and Justice George E.Penny as a committee to see about more highways to the water in the Town of Riverhead.

On motion made seconded and carried the Town Clerk was instructed to notify the following to qualify for the office of Constable immediately:

William H.Dayton, Harold Ryder, Arthur J.Howell, and Anthony Przyborowski.

It was decided that the next meeting of the Town Board will be held on Monday, May 15th. at 7-30 o'clock, Daylight Saving Time.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
