REQUEST UNDER SECTION 138A FOR A FORM OF CONSTRUCTION IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF A FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY WITHIN A TOWN.

Town of Riverhead County of Suffolk

RESOLUTION requesting the widening of construction, Fed. Aid Highway in the town of Riverhead as provided in article Six of the Highway Law (Chapter 30, Laws of 1909), as amended, passed by the Town Board of the town of Riverhead, on the 10th day of March, 1921, a quorum being present and Six members voting in favor of such resolution and none members voting against the same.

1- Whereas the State Commission of Highways has determined to construct or improve as a Fed. Aid Highway with sixteen feet of Reinforced cement concrete pavement portions of the Highways hereinafter described in Par. 2, therefore, be it

2- RESOLVED, That this Board pursuant to Article Six of the Highway Law, requests that the plans for the improvement of the highways as described in this paragraph, be modified as provided in paragraph 3, viz: Beginning at a point on the road from Wading River to the Middle Country Road about 100 ft. northwest of the intersection of said roads, thence easterly along the Middle Country Road through the unincorporated village of Riverhead to C. H. #694 having a total length of 38300 feet as shown on reverse side of this sheet.

3- RESOLVED, That this Board requests that the aforesaid highway be constructed of the classes, lengths and widths of pavement indicated in the following table. The said Board hereby agrees that the additional cost of same, over the Engineer's Estimate for a Reinforced cement concrete


resolution and of the whole thereof.
