

Town Clerk, Joseph W. Kratoville was instructed to write to Congressman, Frederick C. Hicks in reply to his letter of March 1st, 1920 and ask that a cannon be obtained for the Town of Riverhead to be used as a monument and placed as near the Memorial Tablet, ^{as possible} just purchased by the Town of Riverhead.

Town Superintendent of Highways H. V. Lane asked the Town Board for a Public dumping ground and he was instructed to look into the matter thoroughly as to location of same and report back at the next meeting.
