

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Thursday January 2d, 1919 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried Wm. F. Flanagan was appointed a committee to act with Town Supt. of Highways Lane for purpose of taking an Inventory of Machinery etc. owned by the Town.

On motion seconded and carried J. Fred Dugan was appointed to fill the duties of Town Clerk in the absence of Jos. W. Kratoville, Town Clerk who is in the service of the U.S. Army.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor B. Frank Howell was authorized to transfer \$17.25 from Contingent Fund to Board of Health Fund, and to transfer \$403.70 from Contingent Fund to Supt. of Highways Fund.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor B. Frank Howell was authorized to borrow from Suffolk County Trust Co. the sum of \$881.52 for Audited Bills and Supervisor B. Frank Howell and Acting Town Clerk J. Fred Dugan were authorized to secure and deliver to the said Suffolk County Trust Co. a note in the sum of \$881.52 to secure said sum of \$881.52.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that inasmuch as every member of this Board favored the revocation of the Order of June 1918, providing that during the period of the present War the sale of Alcoholic Beverages within the limits of the Town of Riverhead shall be exclusively to be drunk upon the premises, that immediate steps be taken to have such order revoked as in the opinion of the members of this Board the necessity for same no longer exists.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
