Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The Board of Assessors appeared before the Board, as did also Mr. John Bagshaw and ways were discussed for completing the new Tax Rolls so that the errors of the past year would not occur again and so that the assessed valuations in the future would be more in proportion to values.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that this Board take the initiative in the matter of erecting a Memorial to the Boys of the Town of Riverhead who entered their Country's service, and that this Board invite the citizens of the Town to make suggestions as to what form of memorial would be most fitting and proper.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that this Board petition Hon. Herbert S. Sission Commissioner, Department of Excise Albany, N.Y. to abrogate his order of June 13th 1918 respecting the sale of Bottled Liquors in the Town of Riverhead.
