

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday February 28th, 1919 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor Howell was authorized to have a Spl. Deputy Sheriff appointed for purpose of making special investigations.

On motion seconded and carried the following resolution was passed.

Whereas, the Town of Southampton is constructing tide-gates in the Shinnecock-Peconic Canal for the healthful and commercial interests of eastern Long Island.

Resolved:- That we hereby urge our representatives in the State Legislature to use their best efforts to obtain an appropriation of Thirty-Five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for the purpose of constructing a lock in connection with the tide-gates in said Shinnecock-Peconic Canal for the necessary convenience of traffic in bays connected by said Canal.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that the opening of bids for Road Oil be deferred until April 11th, 1919, inasmuch as it was the opinion of members of this Board that the prices for Road Oil would be much lower at that time.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
