

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town  
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday  
August 1st, 1919 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried, Supervisor B. Frank Howell was authorized to borrow from the Suffolk County Trust Company the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty and 90/100 Dollars and place same to the credit of the Contingent Account of the Town of Riverhead and Supervisor B. Frank Howell and Town Clerk Joseph W. Kratoville were authorized to secure and deliver to the said Suffolk County Trust Company a note in the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty and 90/100 dollars (\$1550.90).

The attention of the Town Board having been called to the state of the Town Records, the Town Board considered the best methods of preserving same, and in view of the steps taken by other Towns in Suffolk County for a similar purpose, when after due deliberation it was deemed in the best interests of the Town to have same printed, and the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

That the Town Clerk arrange to have the Town Records from the date of the erection of the Town of Riverhead into a separate Township or Municipal Corporation of Suffolk County, New York to date, printed and bound up in one or more substantial Volumes, at as moderate expense as possible and to instruct the printer to bind up -25¢- separate copies for the purpose of sale or donation.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
