

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday October 3rd, 1919 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion, seconded and carried, Supervisor, B, Frank Howell was authorized to borrow from the Suffolk County Trust Company, Riverhead, N.Y. the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen and Seventy One Hundreths (1516.70) Dollars and Supervisor B. Frank Howell and Town Clerk, Joseph W. Kratoville were authorized to secure and deliver to the said Suffolk County Trust Company a note in the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen and Seventy one hundreths (\$1516.70) Dollars.

Resolution made on October 14th, 1916 and on Page 118 of the Town Board minutes, and reading as follows by motion, made, seconded and carried is hereby rescinded.

On motion it was ordered that each member of Election Boards of the Town of Riverhead receive \$6.00 per Calender day for each day services rendered at Primaries, Registrat-ion and General Elections, including Sept. Primaries and

Registration Days of 1916.

On motion made seconded and carried it was ordered that each member of Election Boards, Inspectors of Elections, Poll Clerks and Ballot Clerks of the Town of Riverhead is to receive \$10.00 for Primary Election and General Election and \$6.00 on each Registration Day.

Justice Robert Burnside and Justice Wm. L. Miller Committee on the purchase of Bronze Tablet and Granite Monument for Soldiers and Sailors memorial reported that they have arranged with the J. W. Fiske Co. to furnish a Bronze Tablet containing the requisite number names for the sum of \$418.00 and further that they have arranged with Frank H. Hill & Bros. to furnish a Granite Monument suitable for the Tablet and affix the Bronze Tablet thereto and set foundations thereto for the sum of \$405.00.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
