Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The Committee on Health Regulations, Justices Burnside and Miller reported favorably on same, and on motion made and seconded the following resolutions were adopted:

WHEREAS: This Board is advised the accompanying health regulations have been adopted by over 400 municipalities of this state and found in accord with modern science and entirely workable, and

WHEREAS: The State Commissioner of Health has recommended the adoption of these regulations by this Board of Health that the health regulations of this municipality may be as nearly uniform with those of others of the State as possibly, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the accompanying health regulations be and hereby are adopted by this Board of Health as the health regulations of this municipality, and be it further

RESOLVED: That all other health regulations now in force that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations be and hereby are repealed, and be it further


RESOLVED: That the Clerk of this Board of Health be and hereby is directed to publish these health regulations in accordance with Sec. 21 of the public health law by posting one copy in his office and one copy in the office of the

health officer for two weeks, and be it further:

RESOLVED: That the Clerk of this Board be and hereby is directed to secure sufficient copies of these regulations of the State Printer, Albany, N.Y. at a cost of not to exceed \$1.85 for 50 or \$3.00 per hundred and distribute one copy to each member of this board, each physician, nurse, clergyman and school teacher of this municipality and hold the remainder for distribution as needed, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Clerk of this Board be and hereby is directed to notify the State Commissioner of Health of the adoption of these regulations.
