Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to renew for period of one year two notes held by Suffolk County National Bank. One in the sum of \$1761.31 and the other in the sum of \$1783.81 to bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum.

The committee on the matter of purchasing property of R. W. Duvall reported that an opinion from Town Counsel had been obtained as to the course to be pursued in the matter and on motion made and seconded it was ordered that the sand and loam be purchased for the sum of \$400, and the Town Counsel was authorized to prepare such papers as necessary and present same to this Board for execution.

A communication was received from the Public Service Commission regarding the Road Bridge over the Rail Road near the Forge and on motion the matter was referred to N.O. Petty for advice as to this Board's status in the matter.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor, Howell was authorized to purchase necessary Tax Rolls to be used by this Town for the ensuing two years, through the Board of Supervisors (Committee on supplies).

Communication was received from the Council of National Defense regarding certain Health Matters and on motion same was referred to Health Officer Terrell.
