Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Meeting called for purpose of considering matter of contracting for Road Oil for ensuing year. The following communication was received from Standard Oil Co. of N.Y.

In reference to our telephone conversation this morning would say that at the present time we are unable to quote any price for road oil. We will be able to give you some definite information about April 1st.

Highway Supt. Downs stated that he had received word from Messrs Brewster & Baylis of Port Jefferson that they were in a position to furnish road oil, and on motion seconded and carried it was ordered that the Town Supt. of Highways, Supervisor and Acting Town Clerk enter into an agreement with Messrs Brewster & Baylis or Company they represent to purchase at least 75000 gals. of 60% asphalt oil and to purchase an additional 25000 gals. if possible. All at 12¢ per gallon F.O.B. Philadelphia, Pa.
