Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that from and after this date the Assessors of this Town receive a per diem compensation of Four (\$4.00) Dollars for each day actually and necessarily devoted by them to the service of the Town in the duties of their office, and to receive in addition thereto their actual disbursements.

A communication was received from Wm. H. Barnes requesting the enactment of a Town Ordinance regarding Parking of cars in front of Residences and on motion seconded and carried the matter was referred to Robert Burnside as a committee to report as to the Board's authority to enact such Ordinance.

Several citizens appeared before the Board and requested that the L.I.R.R. Co. take immediate action to prevent the causing of Forest Fires through negligence of operatives of their Locomotives in the Town of Riverhead, and on motion it was ordered that Acting Town Clerk write the L.I.R.R. Co. relative to the matter.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
