
Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

of an ordinance prohibiting the sale of liquor in packages
to other than licensed retail dealers in the Town of
Riverhead, County of Suffolk and State of New York.

held with the Camp Upton Authorities; and that a meeting be
arranged for with such authorities at some early date.
