Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to purchase sufficient necessary blanks, pages etc. for use in completing Tax Rolls for year 1919.

On motion it was ordered that Supervisor recommend to Town Supt. of Highways that a Raincoat be purchased for Traffic Policeman.

On motion it was ordered that a Special Agreement be entered into with Town Supt. of Highways as follows.

"C" On the road commencing at Depot Lane, Aquebogue, N.Y. and leading East to Jamesport, N.Y. a distance of 2 miles there shall be expended the sum of \$1955.98 dollars for the following kind of improvement Breaking up, oiling and graveling for a width of 16 feet with graveling of 3 inches in thickness. This ~~agreement~~ is intended to be a substitute for improvements "A" and "B" of the agreement dated Feb. 13th, 1918 and the amount to be expended is the total of the sums set aside for improvements "A" and "B".

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
