

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town  
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday  
June 23d, 1917 at 10.00 A.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion the Town Clerk and Supervisor were appointed a Committee to ascertain whether or not the two safes, which are in the Town Clerk's Office could not be exchanged for two safes to comply with the requirements of Division of Archives and History of the State of New York.

On motion, the resignation of Mr. Geo. E. Luce, one of the Commission appointed by the Town Board at a meeting of the Town Board, held June 8th, 1917 was accepted.

On motion, Town Superintendent of Highways, Charles O. Downs was authorized and instructed to write to the New York Telephone Company, directing that the new poles, which they are to place throughout the Town of Riverhead be placed on the boundary line of any Town Highway.

On motion, Supervisor was authorized to have three Special Deputy Sheriffs appointed and to be on duty from six o'clock P.M. on July 3d, 1917 to six o'clock A.M. July 5th, 1917. Such Special Deputy Sheriffs to be paid \$3.00 per diem.

On motion, made, seconded and carried, Mr. Fred B. Jones, of Riverhead, N.Y. was granted a franchise for three years from this date to operate a Bus Line from the West Line of the Town of Riverhead at Manorville, L.I. to the East Line of the Town of Riverhead at Laurel over the River Road and Main Road through the Village of Riverhead, N.Y.

On motion, the next meeting of the Town Board will  
be held on June 29th, 1917 at 10:00 A.M.
