Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Mr. P. L. Housel addressed the Board relative to the  
Salary of the Town Supt. of Highways, and On Motion,  
seconded and carried the Salary of the Town Supt. of High-  
ways was changed from \$4.00 per diem to \$5.00 per diem.

Messrs R. C. Brown, Jacob Meyer and Geo. H. Perkins  
appeared before the Board, and requested that steps be  
taken to oil the River Road and Middle Country Road, up  
to the Town line and leading to Camp Upton, and on Motion,  
seconded and carried Town Supt. of Highways, Downs and  
Supervisor, Howell were appointed a committee to  
investigate the matter and report at a meeting to be held  
on Monday Oct. 8th, 1917 at 10:00 A.M.

On Motion, seconded and carried Acting Town Clerk,  
J. Fred Dugan was ordered to write the proper Federal and  
State authorities requesting that some action be taken in  
the way of getting appropriations by the State and Federal  
authorities for permanent improvement to the  
Riverhead Town Highways leading to Camp Upton.
