Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion
adopted.

On motion seconded and carried the following
resolution drawn by County Supt. of Highways, Peter Elbert
Nostrand was duly passed.

"WHEREAS The location of Camp Upton near the Town
has brought such traffic upon the Highways leading thereto
that it becomes necessary to repair and oil such Highways
to keep them in condition.

WHEREAS This emergency was necessarily unfore-
seen at the time of making up the estimate for highway
purposes, therefore

RESOLVED That this board appropriate the following
amounts to be raised under certificates of indebtedness.

- \$500.00- On the Main Road from Riverhead to Calverton.
- \$500.00- On the Middle Country Road from Calverton to
Parker Road.
- \$500.00- On the Middle Country Road from Parker Road to
Wading River Road.
- \$500.00- On the Middle Country Road from Wading River
Road to western line of Town.
- \$500.00- On the Manor Road from Calverton to Manor.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor, B. Frank Howell, Jr. was authorized to borrow from the Suffolk County National Bank the sum of \$2500.00 for Highway Purposes and Supervisor, B. Frank Howell, Jr. and Acting Town Clerk, J. Fred Dugan ~~was~~ authorized to execute and deliver to the said Suffolk County National Bank a Demand Note in the sum of \$2500.00 to bear interest at the rate of 5% to secure said sum of \$2500.00.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that regular Meetings of the Town Board be held on the 1st and last Saturdays of each month at 10:00 A.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
