
Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted

authorized to hire the "CASINO" and the "LYCEUM" for use  
of the Election Boards in Districts Two and Four on April  
4th. 1916 and for the best prices that could be arranged  
with the Managers of the above places.

On motion Supervisor Corwin was authorized to purchase  
three Blank Assessment Rolls to be used in making up the  
1916 Assessment Rolls.

Mr. William H. Young presented a Petition to the Board  
asking for the establishment of an Electric Light District  
at Aquebogue and on motion the Petition was ordered sent  
to the Town Counsel Mr. Patty for an opinion.
