Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted

On motion Supervisor Corwin was appointed a Committee of one with authority to purchase a Cement Mixer at a price not to exceed \$700.

On motion Town Clerk was ordered to write to the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven to ascertain whether or not the Town of Brookhaven would pay the bills for fighting fire which were incurred by reason of persons residing in the Town of Riverhead being compelled to fight a forest fire which recently swept through the Forests near the Village of Wading River.

On motion it was ordered that suitable notice be drafted and published in the local papers for Six Weeks warning persons against Speeding or Reckless driving of Autos, or the use of Cut Outs on Autos and also against driving without proper Lights and also against riding Bicycles on the Sidewalks or without proper Lights, and it was further ordered that 100 Cardboard Signs be printed and distributed about the Town by the Town Clerk such signs to cover above matters.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
