O'clock P.M. on July 3d. 1916 to 6 O'clock A.M. July 5th. 1916
Such Special Deputy Sheriffs to be paid \$3.00 per diem

On motion the following ordinance was adopted and order
-ed published in the Riverhead News and County Review
four times.

ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk and State of New York, held on June 15, 1914, the following ordinance was presented and adopted according to law:
"It shall be unlawful for any person to set off at any time any fire crackers whatever on the public highways in the Town of Riverhead, and it shall also be unlawful for any person or persons to build bonfires or to set off any fireworks on the public highways in the said Town of Riverhead at any time. Any person

violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable in a case of conviction by a fine not exceeding \$50 or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
The authority to pass this ordinance is found in Art. 2 of the Public Health Laws of the State of New York.
