

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Saturday May 22d, 1915 at 10:00 A. M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Bids were submitted to this Board by Hagen & Lee and H. H. Williamson for printing 500 Phamplets containing proceedings of Board of Audit for year 1914 and according to Town Law Sec. 133; the bids were as follows:

H. H. Williamson	\$33.75
Hagen & Lee	\$32.50

On motion it was ordered that the Bid of Hagen & Lee, the lowest bidder be accepted and that Hagen & Lee be instructed to proceed with the Work.

On motion it was ordered that on completion of said Phamplets, notice of completion of same be published two times in local papers.

Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor submitted to the Board his Bond or Undertaking for Highway Moneys, same being in the sum of \$45,000.00 and on motion said Bond or Undertaking was approved.

On motion it was ordered that hereafter Town Superintendent of Highways, William A. Brown be allowed the sum of \$2.50 per day (for six days in each week) to cover actual and necessary expenses incurred by him in the performance of his Official duties, this in addition to his regular per diem allowance of \$4.00/

On motion Supervisor, Corwin and Town Superintendent of Highways, William A. Brown were appointed a Committee to make an estimate of the cost of repairing the Town Dock and report at next Meeting.

On motion the Town Superintendent of Highways was authorized to have the Main Road defined, laid out and properly monumented beginning at a point near Upper Mills where the last definite monument is located and extending through to the East Line of the Town.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
