Dear Sir:

To yours of March 30th, 1914, I wish to state that  
while I am perfectly willing to present the Town with a  
deed for the land I referred to in letter of March 20th, 1914  
whenever the Town is ready to establish a real or legal  
Town Dock thereon. I do not understand that a deed or any-  
thing more than the old recorded proceeding establishing  
a Highway is required to warrant keeping same in repair.

To establish a public dock, the Town should own


the land, but a highway requires only a right to pass over the land and with this right goes the responsibility of keeping such highway or street, in repair, it seems to me. However the deed will be prepared as per above if we understand each other and it will be satisfactory.
