We, the undersigned, having met and considered the


application of Emma L. Perkins to alter the River Road in the Town of Riverhead, as set forth in her application dated July 30th, 1914, and hereunto annexed, and having heard the allegations both in favor of and in opposition to such proposed alteration, and after due deliberation thereon, do hereby consent that the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead make an order altering the highway known as the River Road, pursuant to said application of Emma L. Perkins, by changing the course of a part of its centre line at or near Upper Mills so that it will run as follows:

Beginning at a point in the centre line of River Road south three degrees seven minutes west the distance of twenty-four and $\frac{8}{10}$ feet from a monument on or near the boundary line between the lands of Louis Yaegar and the lands of the heirs of J. R. & J. H. Perkins, and running thence north eighty-two degrees, twenty minutes west the distance of ninety-three and $\frac{7}{10}$ feet, thence north sixty-seven degrees, fifty-nine minutes west a distance of ninety-two and $\frac{7}{10}$ feet, thence north forty-seven degrees twenty-eight minutes west the distance of about one hundred ninety-one and $\frac{6}{10}$ feet to the centre line of the River Road, the said altered River Road to be three rods in width.
