An order having been made on the 14th day of April, 1914 by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, establishing within said Town a water district to be known as the Riverhead Water District, and said Town Board having ad-

journe'd from the 14th day of April, 1914 to this day for the purpose of considering the selection of water commissioners for said water district, and having met on this day pursuant to said adjournment,

Now, therefore, we, the undersigned, members of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, pursuant to Section 285 of the Town Law, do hereby appoint three tax payers resident within said district as Water Commissioners of said Riverhead Water District, each Commissioner to hold office for the period set opposite his respective name, viz:

WILLIAM F. FLANAGAN	for a term of three years,
H. HARRISON CORWIN	for a term of two years
O. EDMUND GRISWOLD	for a term of one year.

And we do hereby ORDER AND DIRECT that this order be filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead, and be by him recorded in the minutes book of said Board.
