On motion Supervisor was authorized to transfer
\$200.00 from Contingent Fund to Overseer of Poor Fund and
\$250.00 from Contingent Fund to Board of Health Fund.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to purchase
Steel Ballot Boxes as requested by Election Commissioners
at a cost not to exceed \$8.00 per district instead of
\$7.25 per district as voted on August 1, 1914 also to
purchase such new voting Booths as might be necessary for
the various Election Districts of the Town.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to have three
Special Deputy Sheriffs appointed to act on Tournament
Day and Five Special Deputy Sheriffs appointed to act
during the Fair each Special Deputy Sheriff to receive
a compensation of \$3.00 per day.
