A report was received from William A. Brown, Town Superintendent of Highways to certain resolutions to certain resolutions which were presented to this Board at a meeting held April 27, 1914 and referred to Town Superintendent of Highways for investigation.

On motion it was ordered that all shows known as Circus be required to pay a License fee of \$25.00 and all shows known as Wild West or Dog & Pony Shows be required to pay one half of such fee or \$12.50/
