

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall, Thursday, July 10th, 1913, at 1:00 P.M.

Meeting called to order by Supervisor.

Supervisor calls for a report of committee appointed at meeting held June 10, 1913 in matter of water district.

The committee presents opinion from Nathan D. and Nathan O. Petty, attorneys, and same is read by Town Clerk.

Supervisor invites discussion of question and the same is generally discussed.

Mr. David E. Warner, Justice, moves that pursuant to the opinion of said Attorneys the petition for the establishment of a water district pursuant to petition filed May 23, 1913 be dismissed; seconded; carried.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to pay vouchers of persons employed in fighting forest fires.

On motion Town Attorneys, Nathan D. and Nathan O. Petty were instructed to render an opinion as to method by which Bicycle Ordinance adopted on June 20th, 1913 could be enforced.

Mr. John R. Vunk representing the Consumers Gas Company of Long Island applied for a franchise or consent to lay Gas Mains and Gas Pipes in the various Highways of the Town of Riverhead.

On motion the matter was laid on the table until the next meeting of the Board.

There being no further business, Meeting adjourned.
