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MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Monday,
August 25th, 1913 at 2:00 P.M.

On motion a Franchise was granted to the "Consumers Gas
Company" to lay Gas Mains and Gas Pipes in the various
highways of the Town of Riverhead, upon terms and conditions
as set forth in the original Franchise as filed in Town
Clerk's Office on this date.

On motion Supervisor and Town Clerk were instructed by
the Board to purchase from time to time and at the expense
of the Town of Riverhead such stationery, Office supplies and
incidentals as they (the Supervisor and Town Clerk) might
deem necessary for their use in conducting the affairs of
the Town.

On motion, Supervisor was instructed to purchase a Burr-
oughs Adding Machine at a cost of not exceeding \$275.00
and at the Town's expense.

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Resignation of William L. Snell as Inspector of Election for 3^d District of Town of Riverhead was presented to and accepted by the Board.

On motion, Ernest M. Robinson was appointed Inspector of Election for the 3^d district of the Town of Riverhead to fill out the unexpired term of William L. Snell resigned.

On motion it was ordered that the Town Clerk be paid for his services in relation to Election matters a fee of \$2.00 per day except when required to travel out of the Village of Riverhead in order to carry out his duties under the election Law and in such instances he to receive a fee of \$5.00 per day.

On motion Town Clerk was appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics in and for the Town of Riverhead.

On motion, Lorimer M. Raynor was appointed attendance Officer in and for the Town of Riverhead at \$2.00 per day for actual services rendered and \$.05 per mile for each and every mile traveled in the performance of his Official duties. This in addition to the regular allowance for horse hire.

On motion the following resolution was passed:

At a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, held in the Town Clerk's Office, August 25th, 1913, the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved: that it shall be unlawful for any person


or persons, firm or corporation, to disturb, tear up, or otherwise interfere with any of the Stone or concrete highways in the said Town of Riverhead, except by and with the consent and authority of the Town Superintendent of Highways of said Town and under his supervision, authority and control.
Be it further

Resolved: That all the expense incident to the repairing and placing in proper condition of said highways after tearing up, disturbing or otherwise interfering with such highways as herein provided shall be borne by the person, or persons, firm or corporation requesting such change or disturbance and be it further

Resolved that copies of this resolution be ordered printed by the Town Superintendent and mailed to property owners in the Town of Riverhead.

On motion, it was ordered that no License be issued to any Circus for a fee of less than \$25.00.
