First District, Wading River Hall, Wading River, N. Y.

Second District, Odd Fellows Hall, Riverhead, N. Y.

Third District, New Casino, Riverhead, N. Y.

Fourth District, Harmony Hall, Jamesport, N. Y.

On motion it was ordered that if the Supervisor deemed it necessary, he was to have an electric light placed on Orsborne Ave., Riverhead Village, between Lincoln Ave. and Long Island Railroad

A Committe composed of Wm. S. Reeve, R. C. Brown, add Howard E. Hulse appeared before the board upon behalf of the residents and Taxpayers of the Village of Calverton to protest against the laying out of a new

Highway at Calverton, extending from the Old road on the property late of Wilson J. Benjamin on the North side of the Long Island R. R. Tract and across various owners to land of W. Adamcieski where^x intersects the Old Road, The Commi+tee stated that they understood that application had been made for the above described road, inspite of the almost unanimous feeling against it upon the part of the residents of Calverton. As no Commission has been appointed relative to above road, the Board did not deem it necessary to take any Official Action at this time, but promised^x the members of the Committee that at the proper time, the Board would take the matter under consideration and take wuch steps as the said Board deemed necessary at the proper time.
