Roanoke Ave. opposite the residence of Phillip Haberman.


On Motion the application was granted and the Board
entered into the following agreement with the Stock Co.
represented by Messrs. Robinson and Neinstedt and known
as the Roanoke Scale Co.

"RESOLVED" That a permit be and the same is hereby
given to the Roanoke Scale Co., to construct and maintain
a scale or weighing machine on the East side of Roanoke Ave.
in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, on or
near the land of Phillip Haberman, in such a way and manner
as will not interfere with the public use of such thorough-
fare. it being expressly understood and agreed by and between

the said Town Board and the said Roanoke Scale Co., that should any accident occur by or from the placing of said scales or weighing machine within the line of said Highway that the said Town of Riverhead shall be saved free and harmless from all damages caused thereby the said Roanoke Scale Co., being ~~sole~~ responsible therefore and this permit is granted upon this express understanding.

The New York Telephone Company presented an application for permission to place subway and cable Conduits with necessary manholes upon several of the principal Streets of Riverhead Village, but as the Board did not feel that it had sufficient information on the subject, the matter was laid upon the table until next Meeting.

There being no further business, Meeting adjourned.
