Dear Riverhead town board: For those of you who are not aware, last Thursday Councilman Dunleavy sent out to a few Wading River neighborhoods Great Rock's petition solicited support for an official public hearing to allow a code and yield changes so that Great Rock could build an otherwise prohibited golf villa rental complex.

The premise is that our responses will help Mr. Dunleavy make his decision.

John, I am flabbergasted that you spent taxpayer dollars for a survey to help you make this decision in light of the overwhelming public outcry against this proposal, the illegality of the proposed rezoning, and in light of the fact that it has been uncovered that Great Rock has misled us all as to their financial situation.

I am disturbed that you have now resurrected and thus are, in essence, advocating for what by all accounts seemed to have been a dead issue after it was exposed that Great Rock has misrepresented

their situation to the town board and to residents in order to garner support for their petition and their development project.

I, the RNPC and the Wading River Civic (Mike Harrigan, the president, couldn't join us as he's away, are strongly opposed to a public hearing on this issue for a long list of reasons. I would like to mention just a few of them:

There is no application for a zone change that I know of in front of the town board and no procedural justification to consider a public hearing.

The proposed rezoning and gifting of development rights that don't exist completely violates the master plan and thus would be illegal.

Paving the way for this business to over-commercialize our neighborhood would set a precedent for every other would be over-developer to circumvent the code and strip the residents of many of their property rights.

Many neighbors have expressed their opposition to the over-development of this area because it would detract from their enjoyment and value of their homes and we feel we should not be disregarded. I would like to mention that Patty Slack, Brad Slack, Mickey Andriani and Jeanne Marie Krauss all expressed their strong opposition at the May 18 town board meeting that was never televised - and that Christine LaMonica and Jim and Elizabeth Devaney, among others, wrote letters to the town board to the same effect last month which have not yet been published as correspondence.

Great Rock misled us all as to their financial situation and not only duped this board but many of your constituents (I know of at least 13 retractions). To consider rewarding this business for its deplorable behavior makes a mockery of our system of government and is on a path to selling out its residents.

The percentage of neighbors who might respond in favor of a public hearing does not alter the illegality of the rezoning nor does it lessen the negative impacts to the neighborhood and the town. Government should not be run by petitions or polls; it should be run by laws.

John, though I don't believe for a second that it has any

validity, the reason persistently cited for considering paving the way for a rental complex was that Great Rock would go out of business shortly unless they could get fast approval for this rental complex.

Since that is not the case (as their May 20 ad attests to) and they have admitted their financial goals are instead to stabilize the profit margin, can you tell me why you are still trying to advance the idea of a public hearing?

Are any other town board members planning to review their responses?

And can you confirm who paid for this mailing and how much it is costing?

As residents we are not supposed to have to fight to have our town board members uphold the codes and laws that protect our rights as homeowners. Although we will continue to stand up for these rights as long as we have to, I respectfully request that you, and any other board members who may support this issue, drop this misguided golf villa issue once and for all.
