

**TOWN OF RIVERHEAD**

**Resolution # 911**

**AWARDS BID FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES FOR THE RIVERHEAD REFUSE AND GARBAGE DISTRICT**

Councilman Dunleavy offered the following resolution,

which was seconded by Councilman Wooten

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Riverhead sought to procure residential solid waste, bulk waste, yard waste and recyclables collection and disposal services for the Town of Riverhead for six contract bid areas (Contract Bid Areas A through F) within the Town of Riverhead; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Solid Waste Management Plan and Comprehensive Recycling Analysis filed with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation the Town of Riverhead was required to revise bid specifications and make a modification to specifications to incorporate resource recovery; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town retained the professional engineering services of Cashin Associates, P.C., a firm with vast experience in the area of solid waste engineering and planning services, to assist the Town with preparation of bid specifications and review of all anticipated bids; and

**WHEREAS**, after completion of the preparation of bid specifications, the Town Clerk was authorized to publish and post a notice to bidders for residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Services; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were received, opened and read aloud on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2011 at 11:00 am at Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, the date, time and place given in the Notice to Bidders and the Town Clerk prepared an Open Bid Report annexed hereto and made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Sanitation Department for the Town of Riverhead, together with James Heil of Cashin Associates, P.C. and Office of the Town Attorney reviewed all documents related to the bid, bid opening report, bid responses, and reviewed and verified qualifications; and

**WHEREAS**, after review of the above, the Superintendent of Sanitation Department for the Town of Riverhead, together with James Heil of Cashin Associates, P.C. recommend that the Town Board deem European American Waste Disposal Corporation to be the lowest responsible bidder for all six contract bid areas (Contract Bid Areas A through F) based upon the base bids (Contractor responsible to deliver solid waste to a permitted recyclables processing facility for processing and marketing as recovered materials) and alternate bids (Contractor deliver all collected recyclables to Brookhaven MRF pursuant to an Inter-municipal Agreement between Town of Riverhead and Town of Brookhaven); and award the bid for said contract areas to European American Waste Disposal Corporation subject; and

**WHEREAS**, after review of the above, the Superintendent of Sanitation Department for the Town of Riverhead, together with James Heil of Cashin Associates, P.C. recommend that the Town Board award the bid for all six contract bid areas to European American Waste Disposal Corporation based upon the base bid conditioned upon Town's ability to and right to exercise, upon thirty days written notice, modification of the bid awards to reflect, incorporate and enforce all terms and conditions of the alternate bid specifications, to wit: all collected recyclables shall be delivered to Brookhaven MRF pursuant to an Inter-municipal Agreement between Town of Riverhead and Town of Brookhaven and subject to terms and conditions set forth in bid specifications/contract); and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, acting as the governing body of the Town of Riverhead Refuse and Garbage District, deems European American Waste Disposal Corporation to be the lowest responsible bidder for contract bid areas A through F based upon the base bids and alternative bids and hereby awards the bids for all contract areas to European American Waste Disposal Corporation based upon the base bid conditioned upon Town's ability to and right to exercise, upon thirty days written notice, modification of the bid awards to reflect, incorporate and enforce all terms and conditions of the alternate bid specifications, to wit: all collected recyclables shall be delivered to Brookhaven MRF pursuant to an Inter-municipal Agreement between Town of Riverhead and Town of Brookhaven and subject to all such terms and conditions, including but not limited to, compliance with prevailing wage rates set annually by the New York State Commissioner of Labor, performance security, insurance, as set forth in the bid specifications/contract; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a copy of this resolution to European American Waste Disposal Corporation, Sanitation Superintendent; Accounting Department, Attention Bill Rothaar and Personnel Department Attention Jean Miloski; and

**RESOLVED**, that all Town Hall Departments may review and obtain a copy of this resolution from the electronic storage device and, if needed, a copy of same may be obtained from the Office of the Town Clerk.
