## Amendment to Chapter 62

### Legislative Intent

The Riverhead Town Board hereby finds that topsoil, sand, and gravel are valuable natural resources and further recognizes that the excessive excavation and removal of these raw materials results in the elimination of stable ground cover and natural vegetation and further results in the degradation of slopes and alteration of natural drainage swales which could result in impacts to contiguous real property.

In this regard, the Town Board desires to discourage the unwarranted excavation of these resources in the development of industrial and commercial sites and ensure environmentally sensitive real property development to the maximum extent practicable.

### Amendment

To amend Chapter 62 – Excavations:

#### Section 62-10 – Fees

The Town Board or its designee shall charge and collect the following fees for excavation of topsoil, sand and gravel pursuant to approved site plans, grading plans, and realty subdivisions as required by the Zoning Ordinance.

- A. For commercial and industrial subdivision, site plans, grading plans a fee shall be imposed in the amount of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per cubic yard for all material removed from the site in accordance with Town requirements for drainage, parking and other Town required improvements. Further, a fee shall be imposed in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00) per cubic yard for all material removed from the site for any and all purposes and improvements other than those required for compliance with Town requirements.
- B. All fees required pursuant to this Chapter shall be due upon final conditional approval of land subdivisions made by the Planning Board and final approval of site plans or grading plans made by the Planning Board .
- C. An applicant for subdivision approval or site plan approval shall submit an estimate of the volume of materials to be removed as certified by a professional engineer, to either the Planning Board or Town Board as required. The determination of the fees to be paid shall be made by the Town Board or the Planning board subsequent to a review of the estimate submitted.

### HOME RULE REQUEST IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL S.6751 AND ASSEMBLY BILL A.9692-A

**WHEREAS**, currently there is an act to amend Town Law, in relation to authorizing the establishment of the Riverhead Community Preservation Fund; and to amend the Tax Law, in relation to authorizing the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead to impose a Real Estate Transfer Tax with revenues therefrom to be deposited in said Community Preservation Fund and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, a Home Rule request has been received by the Town of Riverhead in support of the above captioned legislation;

**WHEREAS**, this legislation will further the establishment of a Town Community Preservation Fund which would be funded by up to a 2% levy on transfers of real property within the Town and thereby enable the Town to preserve open spaces, recreational areas, and environmentally sensitive lands.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead be and hereby supports this initiative, approves the Home Rule request in furtherance of Senate Bill S.6751 and Assembly Bill A.9692-A and pursuant to Article IX of the State Constitution and the Municipal Home Rule Law, hereby requests the New York State Legislature to enact said legislation; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Supervisor is requested to execute and have certified the attached Home Rule request forms; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Office of the Supervisor and the Office of the Town Attorney and the appropriate agencies.
