**WHEREAS**, in preparation for the land conveyance, the Town of Riverhead has been aggressively marketing the former Grumman property in Calverton for more than one year and has recently contracted with the nationally-renowned consulting team of Hamilton, Rabinovitz and Alschuler for the development of a Comprehensive Reuse and Land Use Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Hamilton, Rabinovitz and Alschuler has recently presented the first phase of their work towards the completion of the Comprehensive Reuse Plan for use in assisting the Town of Riverhead Community Development Agency and the public in attracting appropriate economic redevelopment at the Calverton facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hamilton, Rabinovitz and Alschuler is expected to complete said Plan in early 1996, prior to property conveyance by the U.S. Navy, at which time marketing of the site will become even more intense; and

**WHEREAS**, the Long Island Association has begun substantial work on Project Long Island, a major initiative aimed at bolstering the region's economy through promoting compatible business growth; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Long Island consists, in part, of a \$450,000 study to identify the major industries in which Long Island can compete globally; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Long Island will result in the development of a region-wide marketing publication called "Advantage Long Island;" and

**WHEREAS**, "Advantage Long Island" will be distributed to major prospective businesses across the United States and the world-wide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Riverhead Town Board/Community Development Agency believes that the former Grumman facility in Calverton to

be the premier industrial property on Long Island and should be thoroughly marketed to benefit the entire regional community;
