AUTHORIZES SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL TO NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION

Councilman Prusinowski offered the following resolution,  
which was seconded by Councilwoman Gilliam.

WHEREAS, on September 7, 1993 the Riverhead Town Board, by Resolution #572, identified mitigation of water pollution due to highway runoff as a source of pollution of Long Island Surface Waters and Wetland Systems and directed the Riverhead Conservation Advisory Council to inventory and prioritize those locations requiring improved stormwater management facilities to prevent non-point source pollution of the estuary and freshwater wetlands; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated 3/1/94, the Riverhead Conservation Advisory Council found that the following tributary areas are significant contributors to non-point contamination of waterways, and particularly of the Peconic Estuary:

- a). Meetinghouse Creek/Church Lane/N.Y.S. Rte. 25;
- b). Terry's Creek;
- c). Twin Ponds at Wading River;
- d). Manor Lane to Peconic Bay;
- e). East Creek;
- f). Downtown Riverhead Hamlet; and

WHEREAS, it has been identified by the East End Economic and Environmental Task Force (Institute) that the abatement of pollution due to road runoff is a priority for the east end to achieve protection of the coastal area and waterways; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting on June 8th, with the New York State Department of Transportation, the Town of Riverhead presented the priority sites identified by the Conservation Advisory Council and the proposed mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, at the direction of Governor Mario Cuomo, State Transportation Commissioner John Egan has directed Regional Staff to incorporate the Town's proposal into the State's capital program for highway improvement; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation has requested submission of a formal proposal totalling approximately

\$1 million dollars for mitigation of pollution to road runoff at the aforementioned sites; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director has completed the preparation of said proposal.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Community Development Director to submit to the New York State Department of Transportation a proposal aimed at minimizing road runoff pursuant to input provided by the Riverhead Conservation Advisory Council and with particular focus on the prevention of pollution of the Peconic Estuary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to Andrea Lohneiss, Community Development Director; Betty Brown, Riverhead Conservation Advisory Council; Richard Hanley, Planning Director; and Charles Bloss, Highway Superintendent.
