

# 383 RESOLUTION CALLING PUBLIC HEARING OF MAPLE TREE ESTATES  
FOR A LATERAL WATER MAIN

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by the owners of Maple Tree Estates subdivision for the installation of a lateral water main of the Riverhead Water District to serve their realty subdivision known as Maple Tree Estates, and

WHEREAS, a map and plan has been proposed by H2M, consulting engineers to the Riverhead Water District, and

WHEREAS, the extension comprises thirteen (13) single family building lots located 333 feet north of Northville Turnpike on the west side of Doctors Path, Riverhead, New York, and

WHEREAS, the map and plan, upon completion, will be available for review and inspection at the Office of the Riverhead Town Clerk, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, during normal business hours, and

WHEREAS, the project will consist of an 8X6 tapping sleeve and valve on Doctors Path and the installation of about 920 feet of 8 inch cement lined ductile iron water main and 2 hydrants, together with required appurtenances and 13 water service connections, for a total cost of \$36,600, and

WHEREAS, all costs associated with this lateral shall be borne by the petitioner and the petitioner will be required to pay key money in the amount of \$2,500 for each proposed dwelling unit for a total cost of \$32,500. This cost represents the infrastructure costs to the Riverhead Water District to service these additional residences, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to call a public hearing to consider the aforementioned petition,

108-56. Signs.

Z. Computerized Electronic message centers shall be permitted by special permit of the Town Board in the Business B (with the exception of NYS Route 25), Business C (except in the Hamlet of Wading River) and Business E Highway Commercial/Service Zoning Use Districts only and shall be subject to the following conditions:

(1) On-premises only;

(2) Free-standing, accessory to and incorporated within the main sign structure subject to the following conditions:

(a) Free-standing sign: No more than thirty (30) square feet in total area and an aggregate square footage of all signs on the sign

- structure shall not exceed 50 square feet; and
- (b) Free-standing directory sign: No more than thirty (30) square feet in total area and an aggregate square footage of the Computerized Electronic message center and the shopping center identification shall not exceed fifty (50) square feet. Each business establishment name shall be permitted, in addition to the fifty (50) square feet, no more than ten (10) square feet in total area;
- (3) Minimum display necessary to convey intended message;
- (4) A minimum of three hundred (300) lineal feet from any other existing Computerized Electronic message center;
- (5) No horizontal travelling or vertical scrolling moving messages, animation or graphics shall be permitted;
- (6) A minimum time interval of five (5) seconds between flashed readings of a message;
- (7) That the total number of Computerized Electronic message centers shall not exceed one (1) Computerized Electronic message center for each directory or free-standing sign at the premises;
- (8) At no time shall both a marquise and an Computerized Electronic message center be permitted on the same premises;
- (9) Signs are to be subject to Architectural Review Board review and recommendation.
