(ASSEMBLY BILL 12041)"

Resolved, that pursuant to Article IX of the State Constitution and the Municipal Home Rule Law, this local legislative body hereby requests the New York State Legislature to enact A. 12041 entitled.

# 552 AUTHORIZES REDUCTION OF SUBDIVISION BOND OF LOUIS BONAVITA & SONS, INC. (DUCK POND ESTATES)

Councilperson Lombardi offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilperson Boschetti:

WHEREAS, by resolution of the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead, Louis Bonavita & Sons, Inc., were required to post a bond in the amount of \$550,000.00 for the installation certain improvements to streets, highways, curbing and installation of drainage improvements in the subdivision known as "Map of Duck Pond Estates"; and

WHEREAS, said bond was filed in the Town Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 15, 1988, Louis K. McLean Associates, P.C., Consulting Engineers, recommended that based upon the work that had been completed, the above-referenced bond be reduced.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that the bond in the amount of \$550,000.00 issued by International Fidelity Insurance Co., be and is hereby reduced to \$275,000.00; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that Louis Bonavita & Sons, Inc., shall deliver to the Town of Riverhead a new subdivision bond in the amount of \$275,000.00, upon receipt of which the bond in the amount of \$550,000.00 shall be released; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Peter S. Danowski, Jr., Esq., attorney for Louis Bonavita & Sons, Inc., International Fidelity Insurance Co. and the Riverhead Planning Board.
