Miscellaneous

The addition of two new salt barns in Riverhead to replace the existing buildings that are falling down.
Requesting two new truck bays to wash trucks and contain storm water runoff and reuse salt sand.

Anticipating working with farmers to contain their water on their property for storm water runoff.

Also working with other townships to purchase the filters that are needed for storm water runoff and thereby saving the town taxpayers money.

Start the cleanout of over 65 recharge basins in the Town of Riverhead-winter months.

Requesting the addition of a new salt storage barn out in Jamesport saving money and the environment.

Widen Sound Avenue and the North and South roads for cyclist by obtaining grant money.

Work with school boards on training students in construction and engineering.

Work with other townships on sharing of equipment to save money.

This administration has saved the Town of Riverhead over \$90,000.00 in fines for items not taken care of over the last several years. We have also instituted fees and fines for Road Opening Permits insuring that the roads are not adversely affected by work being done.

We'll be asking the voters in the Town of Riverhead to consider approving a four year term for the position of Highway Superintendent in the upcoming November election.
