Reflexions: Art in the Park *Immersive Light Installation Returns to Riverhead* *Saturday, September 15 @Dusk (6pm-10pm)*

(Riverhead, NY, September 13, 2018) — Riverhead takes the lead on Creative Placemaking on Long Island with a spectacular “light art” installation of immersive reflective art and sculpture along the Peconic River in Downtown Riverhead. **Reflexions** returns to Grangebel Park on Peconic Avenue in Riverhead, New York, for another evening of wonder on Saturday, September 15th. The popup installation is walkable gallery through various forms of light art - sculptures and paintings incorporating LED lights, lasers, reflective materials, luminescents and fire. Admission to the outdoor gallery is free and available all day on Saturday, September 15th with illumination at dusk from 6:00 p.m. to 10 p.m.

Over 2,000 people attended the first two nights of the event in August 2018.

Curated by Clayton Orehek, this year’s exhibit includes work by Orehek, Eli Fishman (a resident Long Island Aquarium artist), Ava Reese, Daphnie Shuttleworth, Judy Richardson and others.

Several art pieces incorporate recycled CDs or DVDs to add a reflective metallic element CD’s can still be donated for the 2019 installation – bright, fluorescent donation boxes are located at the Riverhead Chamber of Commerce, the Long Island Aquarium, Blue Duck Bakery and Riverhead Town Hall.
