In-person inspection of the assessment roll is permitted with only one person at a time in the department. In-person hearings before the Board of Assessment Review will be conducted on a first-come first-served basis as follows:

Since Town Hall is open on a limited basis, Grievance Day is allowed to proceed in the Town Board Meeting room as usual with the following restrictions.

- Maximum capacity in the Town Board Meeting room is 15 grievants (if at any time the number of grievants
 exceeds 15, the additional grievants will be requested to remain outside and will be notified when they can enter
 the building)
- All grievants must check in and be screened. No one with flu like symptoms or a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be allowed to enter the building.
- All grievants must wear masks
- All grievants must keep at least 6 feet from others
- All grievants must occupy seats marked with blue tape
- All grievants will be asked to leave after their complaint

The information desk will also be staffed from 1800 hours to 2000 hours on June 30, 2020 to check in all grievants.

Only those persons wishing to be heard before the Board <u>for the evening session</u> will be allowed inside Town Hall.

NO IN-PERSON APPEARANCE IS REQUIRED, provided a written complaint form RP-524 is filed. All complaint forms (RP-524) <u>must be received</u> no later than 8:00 pm on June 30, 2020.
